
We are writing to inform you that the All Campus Animal Care and Use Committee (ACACUC) at the University of Wisconsin-Madison has revoked animal use privileges of one of our investigators, effective April 1, 2004.


The committee's action prohibits the principal investigator from directly conducting or supervising research with live animals at the university for a period of two years (April 1, 2004 – March 31, 2006). The investigator may apply for reinstatement of animal use privileges after March 31, 2006. This individual may serve as principal investigator on protocols for the purpose of obtaining tissue on the condition that she or any of the staff she supervises are not directly involved in procurement of the tissues.

The University will notify all federal agencies that provide support for the affected research.
