
I am writing to inform you of the All Campus Animal Care and Use Committee's (ACUC) decision regarding your appeal of its March 5th decision to permanently revoke your privileges to use animals in your research at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Following your presentation to the committee and your responses to questions posed by members at the April 2nd ACUC meeting, the membership discussed the grounds for your appeal. After thorough discussion, ACUC members voted unanimously to modify the permanent revocation decision, opting to impose a temporary restriction of your animal use privileges as described below.

The committee's action prohibits you from directly conducting or supervising research with live animals at the university for a period of two years (April 1, 2004 – March 31, 2006). You may apply for reinstatement of full animal use privileges after March 31, 2006. You may serve as PI on protocols for the purpose of obtaining tissue or research material provided that you or any of the staff you supervise are not directly involved in the collection of the material.

The University is obligated to notify all federal agencies that provide support for your research involving animals that your privileges have been restricted.

We regret that this action is necessary.
